Say the beginning sound of one and have your child guess the object.	<input type="checkbox"/> Practice catching, bouncing and kicking a ball.	<input type="checkbox"/> Talk about what pet you would get if you could have any one you wanted. Why would you choose that one?

Really emphasize the /f/ sound.	<input type="checkbox"/> Make a card for a grandparent or neighbor.	<input type="checkbox"/> Read a book about a zoo. Talk about what animals you might see in a zoo.	<input type="checkbox"/> Make up new words to the song, "Old MacDonald had a farm."	<input type="checkbox"/> Make Oobleck—2 parts cornstarch and 1 part water. Is it a liquid or a solid?
<input type="checkbox"/> Paint a picture, mixing paints as you go to create new colors.	<input type="checkbox"/> Use toothpicks to form some letters and shapes.	<input type="checkbox"/> Put 5 toys in order from smallest to largest.	<input type="checkbox"/> Pretend you are a pirate and count to 10 in your pirate voice.	<input type="checkbox"/> Play "Follow the Leader."
<input type="checkbox"/> Clap your hands as you sing each letter of the alphabet.	<input type="checkbox"/> Name some body parts and what you do with them.	<input type="checkbox"/> Find 3 things that are bigger than your hand. 3 things that are smaller.	<input type="checkbox"/> Read a story about a farm. Talk about all the different animals you might see.	<input type="checkbox"/> Count all the squares you can see while reading a book.
