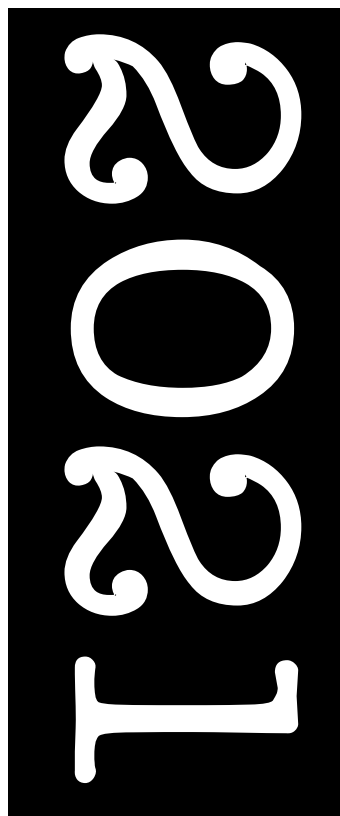
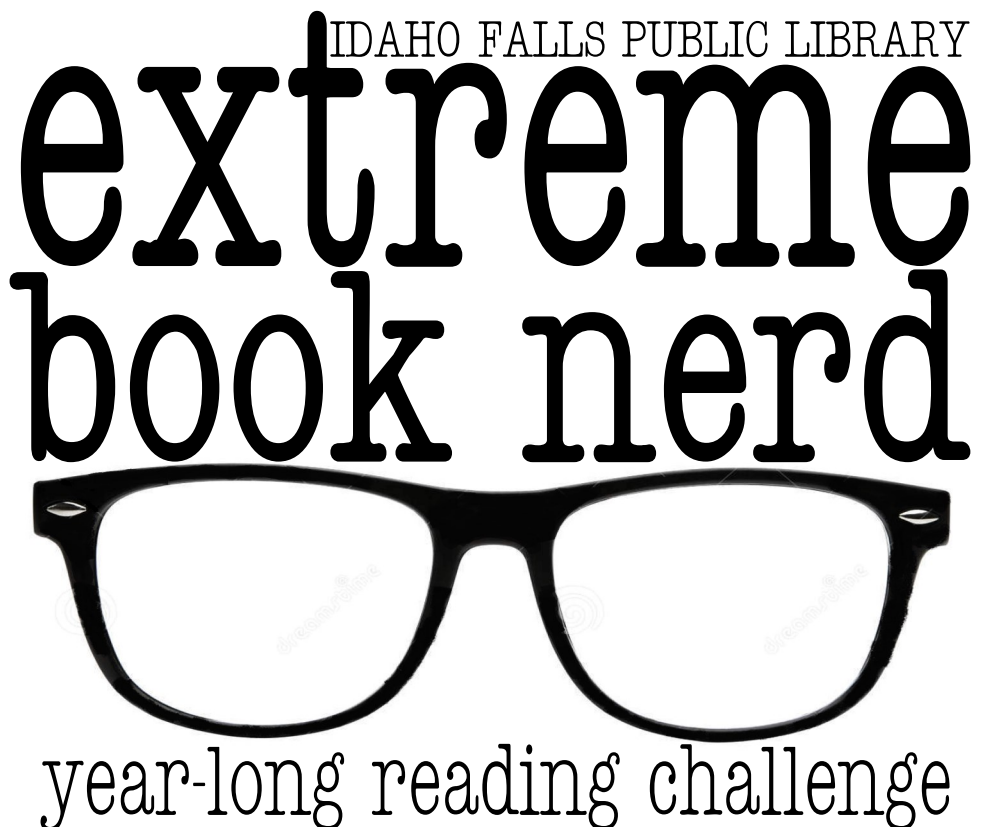

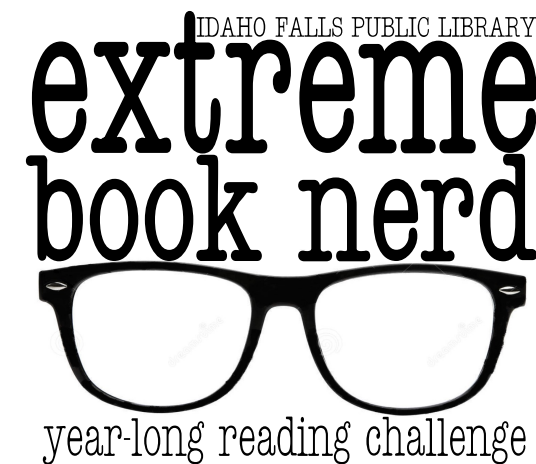

Are you up to the Extreme Book Nerd Challenge 2020?

50 books in 50 weeks



There are 50 categories on the list, and IFPL is challenging you to read books that fall into each of the categories!

Guidelines:

- Extreme Book Nerd Challenge runs January 4 through **December 18, 2021**.
- One category per book, for a total of 50 books in 50 weeks, to be read by **December 18, 2021**.
- All books read for the Challenge need to be recorded in your Extreme Book Nerd reading log on Beanstack with the title and author for each book listed with each category.
 - To be rewarded for finishing the Extreme Book Nerd Challenge, you will have to return to the Library and have a Library staff member sign off on your completed categories in your Extreme Book Nerd reading log by **December 18, 2021**.
 - Reading logs can be a journal, spreadsheet, a list, or simply on Beanstack; you just need to be able to show it to a Library staff member when you are done, and it needs to be logged into Beanstack..
 - Books read for other reading programs and book clubs can be counted toward this challenge as long as they fit into one of the categories (i.e. summer reading program, winter reading program, book clubs, school assignments, etc...) and are done by **December 18, 2021**.
- Books at a Junior fiction level are acceptable, but no other books from the Children's department, including nonfiction, intermediate, easy readers, and picture books. Magazines are also not allowed.
- Teens need to complete 25 out of 26 categories to be awarded the prize. Books beyond the needed 25 will not be counted toward another challenge, nor will another prize be awarded. There is a separate log for teens specifically.
- Participants who finish the challenge by **December 18, 2021** will receive an exclusive Extreme Book Nerd zip-up hoodie.

Only 1 category per book. You cannot use the same book for multiple categories.
