

Are you up to the
Extreme Book Nerd for Kids
Challenge 2023?
25 books in 50 weeks



Guidelines:

- The Book Nerd Challenge runs January 3 through **December 16, 2023**.
- Read 25 books in 25 categories (one book per category) by **December 16, 2023** There are 26 categories - you choose which category to skip.
- You must be an **independent reader** in grades 1-6 and not participating in the teen program.
- The title and author of every book read for Extreme Book Nerd for Kids must be recorded in your Extreme Book Nerd for Kids reading log on Beanstack at ifpl.beanstack.com
- Library staff must sign off on your completed challenge in your Extreme Book Nerd for Kids reading log no later than 5:00pm on Saturday, **December 16, 2023**.
- Reading logs can be a journal, spreadsheet, list, or simply on Beanstack but the final list must be recorded in Beanstack at ifpl.beanstack.com
- Books read for other reading programs and book clubs can be counted toward this challenge as long as they fit into one of the categories (i.e. summer reading program, winter reading program, book clubs, school assignments, etc.) and are completed by **December 16, 2023**.
- Books must be at the Junior Fiction, Junior Graphic Novels, and Junior Nonfiction level or higher. No other books from the Children's department, including intermediate, easy readers, picture books, or board books are allowed. Magazines are not allowed.
- Books must be **at least** 100 pages in length.
- Books beyond the needed 25 will not be counted toward another challenge, nor will another prize be awarded.
- Participants who finish the challenge by **December 16, 2023** will receive an Extreme Book Nerd for Kids backpack.
- **YOU MUST HAVE A CURRENT LIBRARY CARD DURING THE PROGRAM AND WHEN YOU PICK UP YOUR PRIZE IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR PRIZES.**

Only 1 category per book. You cannot use the same book for multiple categories.
