













Play 'Rhyming Match'. Cut out the picture cards. Turn them upside down and lay them in rows. The first person will pick up a card and say what the picture is. Then they will choose a second card and say what that picture is. If the two pictures rhyme, then have the person say another word that rhymes with those two. The person will keep the cards and the next person will take a turn. If the two cards do not rhyme, turn the cards back over and have the next person take a turn. Only put out 4 rhyming matches for beginner rhymers and more cards if the child is able to quickly recognize rhymes.

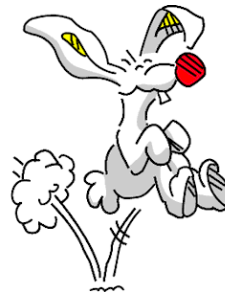

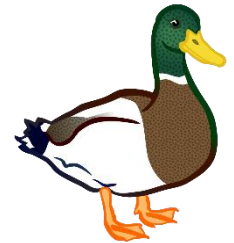

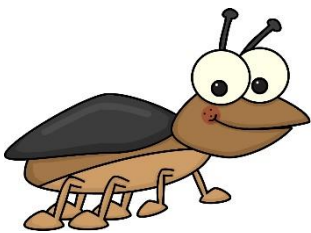
