

KinderPrep Supplemental Beginning Sounds Activity

Shopping for Sounds: Choose an item pictured on the page. If you chose a “potato,” say, “I want to buy an item that starts with /p/ (say the sound).” Then ask your child to search the page and guess which item you’re thinking of. To eliminate confusion, go over the pictures on the page together, so that you agree on the names of the items. Extend the activity by using a page in a catalog or a store sale flyer to do the activity with. Switch roles and have your child say a sound while you guess what they want to buy.



Some of the items in this picture are: pear, strawberry, apple, banana, eggplant, potato, watermelon, tomato, carrot, lemon, juice, etc.
