Kristin Hall made a motion to accept the consent agenda. Claire Pace seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Staff informational reports were given. The children's department report was given by Aleisha Stout. Trustees discussed several policy options, and instructed the director to make changes to the policies and bring to the April meeting for discussion/approval.
